HOMICIDE

On July 17, 2010, at about 11:54 pm, Inglewood Officers responded to the area of 65th Street and Long Street per a radio call of shots fired. While responding to the area the officers were advised of a shooting victim in the street. When the officers arrived they located a male Hispanic juvenile lying on the sidewalk suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Los Angeles County Fire arrived and pronounced the victim dead at 12:10 am.

Based on witness statements obtained at the scene, the victim was walking with friends who left him to walk in a different direction. Several seconds after they separated, the friends heard gunshots and returned to find the victim lying on the sidewalk shot. Although the investigation is still ongoing, the motive for the shooting is not known.
