FATAL TRAFFIC COLLISION

On Tuesday, October 26, 2010, at approximately 6:50 AM, Inglewood Police Officers were dispatched to a traffic collision with injuries at the intersection of Manchester Boulevard and Osage Avenue. Upon arrival, officers determined the collision involved a single automobile and a pedestrian that had sustained significant injuries. Los Angeles County Paramedics responded and pronounced the pedestrian deceased.

Preliminary investigation indicates that a 2004 Lexus RX330 was traveling eastbound on Manchester Boulevard approaching Osage Avenue, when according to witnesses, the pedestrian ran from the southeast corner of Manchester Boulevard and Osage Avenue directly in front of the Lexus.

The pedestrian has been identified as 37 year old Edith Maximo-Medina of Inglewood. The driver of the Lexus, a Hawthorne resident was uninjured and is cooperating with the ongoing accident investigation.
