INGLEWOOD POLICE INVOLVED IN SHOOTING

An Inglewood Police Department sergeant with 14 years of experience was involved in a shooting after confronting two possible burglary suspects. The incident began this morning (January 25, 2012) at 6:00 AM, when Inglewood Police officers were called to a burglary in progress at LaTijera School at 1415 S. LaTijera Boulevard. The school is currently under construction.

An Inglewood police sergeant observed a possible suspect vehicle leaving the area. The sergeant attempted to make a traffic stop in the 4800 block of W. Slauson Avenue in Los Angeles, when an officer-involved shooting occurred. One suspect fled from the vehicle on foot and the other fled in the vehicle east on Slauson. The suspect's abandoned vehicle was later recovered in the 3500 block of W. 58th Place. Both suspects remain at-large at this time.

Inglewood investigators are at the scene and the investigation continues as does the search for the outstanding suspects. The suspects are described as:

#1 – Driver – M/B, age 20-25, medium complexion, short hair, clean shaven, wearing a long sleeve black shirt.

#2 – Passenger – M/B, age 20-30, 5'7" – 5'10", medium build, thin mustache, wearing a black hoodie with white speckles and a zipper.
