Don't Become a Robbery Victim!



A series of street robberies involving gold necklaces, and cell phones, has been occurring in your area. The suspects approach victims on foot, bicycle, or from a vehicle before grabbing their necklaces. The jewelry worn, or cell phone being used, was normally exposed and visible from a distance.

How to protect yourself:

1. Be alert of your surroundings
2. All jewelry and cell phones should be kept secured and not easily seen by the public.
3. Keeping personal items concealed can help decrease the chances of being a target for criminals.
