## **INGLEWOOD POLICE PARTNER WITH POSITIVE RESULTS CORPORATION TO RAISE AWARENESS OF TEEN DATING VIOLENCE ISSUE**

The Inglewood Police Department has forged a partnership with the Positive Results Corporation to raise awareness and support programs in connection with Teen Dating Violence. Representatives from the Inglewood Police Department and Positive Results will be appearing before the Inglewood City Council on Tuesday, January 31, 2012, to address the Council on this important issue. The City Council will be presenting a proclamation declaring February 2012 as “Teen Dating Violence Awareness and Prevention Month” in the City of Inglewood.

The Positive Results Corporation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation dedicated to changing lives by addressing dating violence while enhancing skills and internal resources to build and support positive self image and healthy relationships. Positive Results has made similar presentations before other governmental bodies to bring attention to this issue, including the Los Angeles City Council, where a resolution was passed, declaring February 2010 as “Teen Dating Violence Awareness and Prevention Month” in the City of Los Angeles. Positive Results hosted the first “Stop the Pain, Teen Summit on Dating Violence and Bully Prevention.” The second annual summit is set for April 21, 2012. Executive Director Kandee Lewis said, “We have formed numerous partnerships and supported programs that focus on teen dating violence and look for prevention strategies.”

The Inglewood Police Department supports Ms. Lewis and the Positive Results Corporation in their efforts to prevent teen dating violence and raise awareness of this significant social issue.
