MURDER REWARD

The City of Inglewood is offering a reward in the amount of \$25,000 for information leading to the identification, arrest and prosecution of the person(s) responsible for the murder of Gwendolyn Jefferson Taylor. Ms. Taylor died on Saturday, December 11, 2010 after suffering a gunshot wound while with her family at Roger's Park in Inglewood.

The suspect in this homicide remains outstanding and the Police Department is seeking the Community's assistance in finding those responsible for Ms. Taylor's death.
